

Sweden's support to Ukraine

Sweden's assistance since February 2022*

Sweden also supports Ukraine through the EU and the UN.

Sweden has received some 50 000 Ukrainian refugees.

Sweden has supported Ukraine since the 1990s. Until the end of 2021, Sweden's support to Ukraine amounted to just over SEK 4 billion (approx. EUR 357 million).
